

Fusion Petroleum Technologies Inc. Signs Addendum Agreement for the National Petroleum Assessment and Announces The Commencement of the NPA

July 13, 2006: The Woodlands, Texas

Fusion Petroleum Technologies Inc. announced today that it has concluded and signed an addendum to the Protocol with the Ministry of Energy of the Democratic Republic of The Congo (DRC) for the National Petroleum Assessment (NPA). The addendum to the original agreement provides the sponsors of the NPA with preemptive rights to all onshore acreage in the DRC for the duration of the NPA project. This addendum will protect the rights of the petroleum companies that make the commitment to support the evaluation of the DRC's frontier basins in the interior of the country through the NPA project.

With the signing of the addendum agreement, Fusion also announced that the NPA project will commence officially on August 1, 2006, and that the first sponsor meeting will be held in mid-August. Official invitations will be sent to those companies that have shown interest in joining the consortium. Several major companies have already joined the NPA and it is expected that a group of 10-13 companies will ultimately join the project.

The NPA will be performed in three phases, including (1) a basin-scale petroleum systems study and database construction to be completed within the next year, (2) a national geophysical and geological acquisition and petroleum systems analysis program to be completed by early 2009, and (3) an international bid round and data room for concessions to be offered by DRC to petroleum operators in 2009.

"We are very excited about this critical development regarding the NPA project", said Dr. Alan Huffman, President of Fusion Petroleum Technologies Inc. "Fusion believes that the addendum signed this week with the Minister of Energy will assure the rights of the sponsor companies for the NPA. Fusion is very pleased that the DRC Ministry of Energy agreed to these protections for the NPA sponsors that will guarantee greater interest in the NPA project and enhanced benefits for the people of the DRC."
